**“If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.”**

**Romans 12:18 (NIV)**

God has not called us to be men pleasers. However He instructs that we maintain a peaceful disposition towards all men. While settling an issue between a husband and his wife, a pastor told the husband to love his wife, to which the man blurted out that she was no longer his wife. Then the pastor told him to love her as his neighbour but still, he refused saying she was now his enemy. Then the Pastor looked at him squarely and said, "The Bible says, we should love our enemies and pray for them." The moral of this for us as believers is, there is no getting away from loving people. God loves people and as His children made in His image and likeness, we must love people as well. Meanwhile loving people does not in any way mean indulging them. The Bible warns that open rebuke is better than love concealed.

So, the question is, how should you love people that are not lovable. Here are 3 things you can do.

1. Pray for them and also ask God for wisdom on how to relate with them.
2. Random acts of kindness
3. Be patient and be ready to forgive them.
